The 47 acres that comprise the preserve are diverse and offer many highlights for visitors.

The property is known as "Mill Creek" due to the two branches of this creek that cross the property. The creek is the upper reaches of trout habitat and supports native brook and naturalized brown trout.

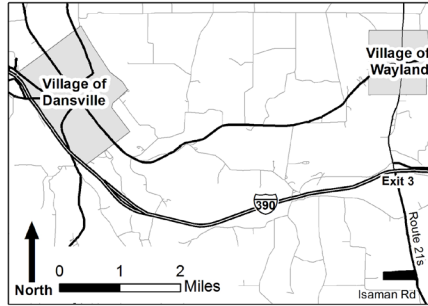
We'll be establishing a trail network in 2020 for your use. In the interim, please feel free to visit the property and enjoy exploring the forest! Stay out of the stream to minimize sedimentation that will hurt the trout and check back for details on the trail system.

Management of the Preserve

The preserve is managed for its habitat and to ensure uses do not negatively impact the trout stream. The Conservancy is allowing natural succession in the forest with work to control invasive species to preserve diversity on the property.

Enjoying this Nature Preserve

Help minimize disturbance by remaining on our maintained trails and staying out of the creek. Enjoy low impact recreation such as hiking, bird watching, and snowshoeing. Keep dogs leashed or under your control.

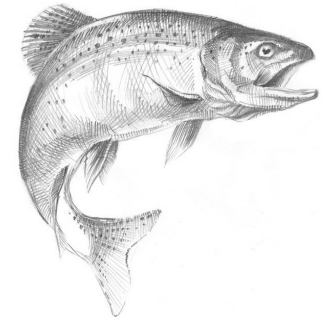

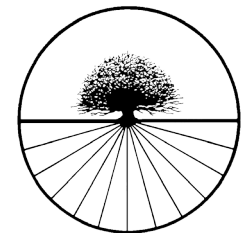
